

3 Days Xian Adventure Tour with Mt. Huashan

Duration: 3 days

Attractions: Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum, Traditional Cave Dwelling, City Wall, Hanyangling Museum, Big Wild Goose Pagoda, Bell or Drum Tower, Muslim Quarter, the Great Mosque, Mt. Huashan

Overview:

Downtown Xian is easy to explore independently but getting out of the city is a challenge if you don't speak Chinese. Treat yourself to a private guide and driver for three days' door-to-door exploration. Besides the historic downtown sites and the Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum, meet farmers at their cave homes, see the second terracotta army at Han Yan Ling Museum, and hike Mt. Huashan.

Highlights

1. Get close to Terracotta Army and see their features;
2. Climb on the City Wall and see the hustle of the city center;
3. Ride a bike on ancient city wall;
4. Stand on the old Bell Tower and listen to the Bell sound;
5. Taste all kinds of local food and snacks in Muslim Quarter;
6. Learn about the Muslim culture in Xian.
7. See one and only underground museum in China - Hanyangling Museum (Jingdi's Tomb);
8. Know about the Buddhism history in Tang Dynasty by visiting the Big Wild Goose Pagoda.
9. Appreciate the Chinese calligraphy and Painting in Shuyuanmen Cultural Street.
10. Be amazed by the magnificence of Mt. Hua;

Itinerary:

Day 1: Terracotta Warriors Museum, Traditional Cave Dwelling, City Wall, Shuyuanmen Cultural

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Street

09:00 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide, your exploration to this great city begins.

09:50 a.m: You will arrive at **Terracotta Warriors Museum**. Your tour guide will take you through every important figures, horses or weapons. By examining the terracotta figures discovered here, you can imagine how Qin soldiers looked like 2000 years ago. From the horse cart and weapons displayed, you will have an idea how these soldiers used to fight. If you look closely enough, you will discover that each figure has different facial expressions, which is very astonishing considering how many figures are there. Then, you will know how great this work must be and why the Terracotta Warriors Museum is regarded as the eighth wonder in the world.

12:30 p.m: Time to hunt for lunch. You will need to cover this fee on spot. Your tour guide will be happy to cater to your needs and find the suitable restaurant for you. Here are some local food you might be interested in: Chinese Hamburger, Baozi (steamed stuffed bun), Spicy soup, Tofu Jelly, Deep - fried dough sticks, Pita Bread Soaked in Mutton Soup, Biang Biang Noodles, Guokui, etc..

13:30p.m: Visit a local family lives in **Traditional Cave Dwelling**. Your tour guide will introduce to you why people like to live here.

14:10 p.m: Depart Terracotta Warriors and get back to the city. It takes about 50 minutes to get back to City from the Terracotta Warriors museum, during which time you can have a little rest and be prepared for the afternoon tour.

15:00p.m: Visit the **Ancient City Wall**, there are two choices available. You can either walk or ride a bike, or even take a golf car (please pay on moment if you want to ride bikes or golf car). This City Wall is the best preserved and most complete wall that has survived through China' s long history. It is about 12 meters high, 12 to 14 meters wide across the top and 15 to 18 meters thick at the bottom. The entire circumference is about 13.7 kilometers. It can take a while if you choose to walk all through.

16:30 p.m: Go to the **Shuyuanmen Cultural Street** and learn about Chinese calligraphy and painting. Its name is originated from the Guanzhong Academy, which was the highest institution of higher learning in the Ming and Qing dynasties in Shaanxi, and now has become a painting and calligraphy center in Xi 'an. There are sound splash-ink works now, and most of the high-quality

goods exhibition, both the street stalls selling arrangement, and elegant display of price tag. When wandering in the street, you will have the misconception of walking in the ancient China. Every year a large number of painting and calligraphy masters converge in Xi' an, holding various kinds of exhibition. You might take part in one of them if you are lucky.

17: 00p.m: Your will be dropped off at hotel and your tour comes to an end.

Day 2: Mt.Hua Hiking Tour

07:30 a.m: Meet your hiking tour guide and set out for the hiking tour.

09:00 - 15:30p.m: **Mt.Huashan** is located 120km southeast of Xian City.It takes around 2 hours to get there. You will have an adventure hiking tour. Mt. Huashan is praised as "the First Odd Mountain in the World". It boasts five imposing peaks with sheer precipices and overhanging rocks. The east one is called the Peak of the Rising Sun which is the best location to view sunrise; the north one, the Peak of Cloud Terrace which is famous for cliffs on its three sides;the west one, the peak of Lotus; the south one, the Peak of Wild Geese which is the main peak and also the steepest of Mt.Hua shan with the elevation of 2,083meters; the Central one, the Peak of the Jade Maiden, which links the east, west and south peaks. Each presents a unique scenic beauty, surrounded by over 70 minor peaks.

17:30 p.m: Drop you off at your hotel.

Day 3: Hanyangling Museum, Big Wild Goose Pagoda, Bell Tower, Muslim Quarter

09:00 p.m: Get ready to be picked up by your smiley tour guide.

09:30 - 12:00p.m: Start your day tour with the only underground museum in China - **Hanyangling Museum**, also called Jingdi's Tomb. It is located near the airport about 30km north of Xian City. This is a burial sight for Emperor Jingdi and his wife Empress Wangzhi. This tomb could be dated back to 2,100 years ago. You will see some of the funeral goods such as pottery figurines dated back to Han Dynasty, Luoqing Stone that was used for measurement, and all kinds of stela inscribed with words.

12:00 - 13:00p .m: Enjoy a Chinese lunch at somewhere local usually go. You will need to cover this

expense on spot. You may try something different from what you had in the last day.

13:40 - 15:30p.m: Your afternoon tour will start with a visit to **Big Wild Goose Pagoda**. It's located inside the Da Ci En temple. It was built in Tang Dynasty to store all the Buddhism sutra and Buddhism figures that Xuan Zang has brought back from India. It's the biggest and also the earliest square pagoda that has been built. Now, it has been remodeled and enlarged like a large park. In the sunny days, local people usually come here and relax themselves. If you come here at night, you will see local people dancing, singing, children running, fountain show performing, and various small stalls setting up for local snacks.

15:50 - 16:30 p.m: Visit the symbol of Xian city - **Bell Tower (Or Drum Tower)**. In ancient times, the bell and the drum were used to strike time in the morning and at dusk because people didn't have clocks or watches, so there is a saying 'Morning Bell and Dusk Drum' in Chinese. The two towers are the name card of Xi'an, as they are the best preserved all around China.

16:30 - 17:00p.m: Located in west of Bell Tower, Muslim Quarter was once a place just for Muslims migrated from other places. As time going by, a unique Muslim culture was formed and this place has become a must-see site for anyone coming to Xian. Hunt for local food, learn about folk art, and explore the mysterious Muslim culture, here is the right place.

17:20 p.m: Finish your day tour and be back to your hotel.

4. The tour we provide you are based on days, not the hours. A regular day tour will last 8-9 hours. In case you only need our service for over 6 hours yet less than 8 hours in one day, we will consider it a day tour.
5. Please be aware that your itinerary is changeable anytime. Whenever you want to adjust it, we will help you with that.
6. What we provide are high-quality private tours, you will be only with your families or friends. There are no other people joining your tour.
7. Wheelchairs are accessible, please advise prior to your trip in case you need any.
8. During your visit to the Terracotta Warriors Museum, you may encounter some local people following you to sell souvenirs, just ignore them.
9. You are free to switch the tour sequence in case of weather conditions.

FAQ

1. Does Mt. Hua hiking tour involve a lot of walking?

Re: Not necessarily, you can hike or take the cable car.

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2.Mt.Hua seems a bit dangerous, isn't it?

Re: Yes, you may see some dangerous parts of the mountain online, that' s what the mountain is famous for. You can avoid the risky part when you climb.

3.Does the tour guide accompany us to climb the mountain?

Re: Yes, in usual cases, your tour guide will escort you through the whole climbing process.

4.Can I take cable car?

Re: Yes, sure. In the quote, both way cable car up and down the West peak is already included.

5.How long is the tour in each day?

Re: The tour lasts about 8-9 hours, starting from the time when you leave your hotel.

6. When does the tour usually end in each day?

Re: The tour usually ends at 17:30 p.m.

7. How long do we have time in the Terracotta Warriors Museum?

Re: You will have a whole morning or afternoon wander in the museum and be immersed in the great wonder.

8. How far is the Terracotta Warriors Museum?

Re: It is about 50 mins drive from city center.

9. Can the itinerary be changed on the spot?

Re: Sure, you can change the itinerary whenever you want. Your tour guide will accommodate your needs.

10. Where do we have lunch?

Re: Your tour guide will take you to a nice local restaurant instead of some tourist ones for lunch.

You can try some delicious meter-long noodles. While on Mt.Hua, you will have lunch on mountain for sure. Please bring some snacks or fast food before you start.

11.How far is the Mt Hua?

Re: It is about 1.5 hours drive from the city center.
