Mutianyu Great Wall, Summer Palace.

Forbidden City, Summer Palace, Temple of Heaven, and old Hutongs. Be amazed by the grandiose

and extravagance of the royal life hundreds years ago. Memorize the historic events happened in

Tian'anmen Square. Walk deep down the old Hutongs and listen to the story of old Beijinger. Visit

the Summer Palace and soaked yourself into the feature imperial park.

Itinerary

Day 1: Tian'anmen Square, Forbidden City, Temple of Heaven, Beijing Hutongs

09:00 a.m: Meet your Beijing local tour guide at your hotel lobby and be ready for the day tour.

09:30-10:15 a.m: Visit the **Tian' anmen Square**. It's a rectangular square with an area of 440,000

sq meters. To some point, the Tian' anmen Square echoes the layout of the Forbidden City. It also

displays the major concept of China politics in ancient times- centralism. There were so many

historic things took place here, of which the most famous one is the Tian' anmen Incident. Now, it'

10:30 - 12:30 p.m: Visit the magnificent **Forbidden City**, the largest Imperial Palace in the world. We'll spend a couple of hours wandering around this amazing example of Imperial architecture and learning about the history of the palace. Surrounded by a long scarlet walls longing 3.5km, UNESCO-listed Forbidden City is the very central power in Ming and Qing Dynasty. This large palace witness the prosperity and the decline of feudalism. From here, you will have a direct experience how royals lived and how they rule.

12:30 - 13:30 p.m: Enjoy a local food in a nice restaurant Beijingers always visit, please pay on moment based on what you have.

14:00 - 15:30 p.m: Head for **Temple of Heaven**. Situated in the southeast of central city, the Temple of Heaven was originally constructed in the eighteenth year of Yong Le (1420) in Ming Dynasty for Ming and Qing emperors to conduct annual ceremonies of praying to Heaven for good harvest. It combines the architectural technology of Ming and Qing Dynasties together, which makes it a rare Chinese ancient architecture and the largest sacrifice complex in the world. Charmed by its size, colorful meaning and importance in China's history, the site was classified into the "Directory of World Heritage" by UNESCO in 1998.

16:00 - 17:00 p.m: Walk in the tranquil **Hutongs**. In those interlaced Hutongs, one can experience the life of the ancient Beijing people. With bathrooms and public toilets usually being found, shops and vendors selling all kinds of goods that satisfy the local people's daily needs, and people gossiping along the lanes to strengthen their relationship, one can walk through the history and savor the unique culture. Thus, we can say that where there is such a lane, there is a story. 17:00 p.m: Drop you off at hotel for rest.

Day 2: Mutianyu Great Wall, Summer Palace

07:30 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide in your hotel lobby and commence your day tour.

09:00 - 11:30 p.m: Drive around 1.5 hours to the **Mutianyu section Great Wall** and you will take a rest and lunch at the Subway down the foot of the Mutianyu Wall. This is a one of the most famous and ideal sections of the Great Wall. You will have your choice of taking the cable car or chair lift up

the breathtaking wall and spend a leisurely 1 to 2 hours hiking up and down the various sections

exploring the Watch Towers and marveling at the construction and beauty of the renown and

legendary Wall. You then have the option of an exhilarating toboggan ride back down or simply

return the way you came with cable car.

11:30 - 12:30 p.m: Enjoy a typical Beijing lunch nearby the Mutianyu Great Wall (pay on moment).

14:00 - 16:00 p.m: Visit the Summer Palace. As the largest imperial garden in China, the Summer

Palace has been a summer resort for royal families. There are huge lakes, bridges, corridors,

pavilions, and various kinds of flowers and lots of rooms fully radiating the natural beauty and the

grandeur of imperial gardens. With arched bridges and glittering ripples, pretty promenades and

flowers in blossom, decorated corridors and ancient doors, and "breezeways" (a kind of hallway

that allows the passage of a breeze between structures), all these can bring tourists into an

enchanting and ever-changing scenery.

16:30 p.m: Come back to hotel and your two day tour ends here.

What's Important:

What's included:

Air-conditioned vehicles with experienced driver.

Entrance fee for sites mentioned, including cable car up and tobaggon down the Great Wall.

3.A regular day tour will last 8-9 hours. If you want a tour with a duration exceeding the working

period of our tour guide and driver, we need to charge you for your extra hours with the standard

of 100 RMB per hour.

4. The tour we provide you are based on days, not the hours. A regular day tour will last 8-9 hours.

In case you only need our service for over 6 hours yet less than 8 hours in one day, we will consider

it a day tour.

5. Please be aware that your itinerary is changeable anytime. Whenever you want to adjust it, we

will help you with that.

6. What we provide are high-quality private tours, you will be only with your families or friends.

There are no other people joining your tour.

7. Wheelchairs are accessible, please advise prior to your trip in case you need any.

8. Please advise in advance in case you want to enjoy the Acrobatic show or Kungfu Show.

9. Please advise prior to your trip if you want to do some activities such as painting, calligraphy,

exercising Tai Chi, watching opera, paper cutting, etc..

FAQ

1. How long do I stay at Forbidden City?

Re: You will stay there about 2.5 hours.

2. What if I want to ride the rickshaw?

Re: That's fine, you can just ask your tour guide to find a rickshaw for you on spot. Of course, you

need to pay then.

3. How do I get on to the Great Wall?

Re: You can take the carlift up and down with the tobaggon, which is already included in the quote.

4. What kind of car will I have?

Re: It depends on your group size. For group size of 1-2 people, you will be offered with a sedan car.

For group size of 3-4 people, you will enjoy a van with 7-seat. While 14-17-seat van will be in service

if there are 5-8 of you. When your tour group size is larger, 33-seat coach or bigger will be offered.

5. Can I confirm this is a private tour?

Re: Yes, this is a private tour just for your group. No other people will join you.

6. Can the tour guide accompany us to have dinner and help us order?

Re: The working time for the tour guide and driver are 8-9 hours. If you finished your tour rather early, our tour guide can certainly help you until you get to dinner. Otherwise, you will need to pay

extra for their overtime work.

7. Can you help to reserve seats for Roast Duck?

Re: Sure, no problem, you just need to tell us what time and where you'd like to have dinner.

Cancellation policy:

No less than 2 weeks, you will lose your deposit;

Within 7 days - 13 days, loss of 50% of your payment or just the deposit.

Within 6 days, loss of full payment or just the deposit.

Please bear in mind that your deposit is still available for your next trip with us. You may also offer

this deposit to someone else as their tour deposit with us.
