Overview: This 14-day long-term trip offers almost all the Chinese elements worth visiting covering Great Wall in Beijing, Terracotta Warriors in Xian, Chinese national treasure Giant Panda in Chengdu, Natural View of Yangtze River between Chongqing and Yichang, and the last stop modern Shanghai. Arrive in Beijing and ease your jet lag before explore this amazing city. Then, take a high-speed train to Xian and pay a visit to the eighth world wonder. Leave for Chengdu where Giant Pandas are housed and take care of them if you apply for Panda Keeper Program. Take a cruise on the third longest river on earth - Yangtze River and be immersed in the absolute beauty of the natural views on both banks. In the end, take a flight to Shanghai and have your last couple of days spent in this charming city before heading back home.

Highlights:

1. Take a luxury cruise on Yangtze River and enjoy its natural wonder.
2. Take care of Giant Panda in panda center and make cookies for them.
3. Visit the world-noted Forbidden City and unveil its hidden mystery.
4. Visit Terracotta Army and make your own warriors if you want.
5. Be amazed by the fast development of Shanghai during the Yangtze River Cruise.

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Beijing

Your driver will be ready at the airport when you arrive and transfer you to hotel. You can ease jet lag in the rest of the day.

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Day 2: Tian'anmen Square, Forbidden City, Summer Palace, Hutong Walking Tour

09:00 a.m: Meet your Beijing tour guide and start your China tour.

09:30-10:30 a.m: Visit **Tian'anmen Square**. With a history of over 500 years, Tian'anmen Square is the largest city square in the world. It's located in the south side of Forbidden City, functioning as the very gate for the imperial palace in Ming and Qing Dynasty. It was in here that the founding of New People's Republic of China was loudly announced. In the following years, there are several historic events happened here that made it a political idol for Chinese people.

10:40 - 13:00 p.m: Visit the magnificent **Forbidden City**, the largest Imperial Palace in the world. We' ll spend a couple of hours wandering around this amazing example of Imperial architecture and learning about the history of the palace. Surrounded by a long scarlet walls longing 3.5km, UNESCO-listed Forbidden City is the very central power in Ming and Qing Dynasty. This large palace witness the prosperity and the decline of feudalism. From here, you will have a direct experience how royals lived and how they rule.

13:00 - 14:00 p.m: Enjoy a local food in a nice restaurant Beijingers always visit, please pay on moment based on what you have.

14:30 - 16:00 p.m: Visit the **Summer Palace**. As the largest imperial garden in China, the Summer Palace has been a summer resort for royal families. There are huge lakes, bridges, corridors, pavilions, and various kinds of flowers and lots of rooms fully radiating the natural beauty and the grandeur of imperial gardens. With arched bridges and glittering ripples, pretty promenades and flowers in blossom, decorated corridors and ancient doors, and "breezeways" (a kind of hallway that allows the passage of a breeze between structures), all these can bring tourists into an enchanting and ever-changing scenery.

16:10- 17:00 p.m: Walk in the tranquil **Hutongs**. In those interlaced Hutongs, one can experience the life of the ancient Beijing people. With bathrooms and public toilets usually being found, shops and vendors selling all kinds of goods that satisfy the local people's daily needs, and people gossiping along the lanes to strengthen their relationship, one can walk through the history and savor the unique culture. Thus, we can say that where there is such a lane, there is a story.

17:00 p.m: End of this day tour and return to hotel for rest.

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Day 3: Mutianyu Great Wall, Bird Nest and Water Cube

07:30 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide in your hotel lobby and commence your day tour.

09:00 - 12:30 p.m: Drive around 1.5 hours to the **Mutianyu section Great Wall** and you will take a rest and lunch at the Subway down the foot of the Mutianyu Wall. This is a one of the most famous and ideal sections of the Great Wall. You will have your choice of taking the cable car or chair lift up the breathtaking wall and spend a leisurely 1 to 2 hours hiking up and down the various sections exploring the Watch Towers and marveling at the construction and beauty of the renown and legendary Wall. You then have the option of an exhilarating toboggan ride back down or simply return the way you came with cable car.

12:30 - 13:30 p.m: Enjoy a typical Beijing lunch nearby the Mutianyu Great Wall (pay on moment).

14:30 - 15:30 p.m: You will head back to the city to visit the National Stadium and National Aquatics Center, also called **Bird Nest and Water Cube**. They were used for the 2008 Beijing Olympics Game. In most times, they are not open for public. You can only take some pictures outside.

16:00 p.m: You will be back to your hotel for rest.

Day 4: Temple of Heaven and head for Xian by railway

09:00 a.m: Meet your personal guide and start your last day tour in Beijing.

09:20- 11:00 p.m: Head for **Temple of Heaven**. Situated in the southeast of central city, the Temple of Heaven was originally constructed in the eighteenth year of Yong Le (1420) in Ming Dynasty for Ming and Qing emperors to conduct annual ceremonies of praying to Heaven for good harvest. It combines the architectural technology of Ming and Qing Dynasties together, which makes it a rare Chinese ancient architecture and the largest sacrifice complex in the world. Charmed by its size, colorful meaning and importance in China's history, the site was classified into the "Directory of World Heritage" by UNESCO in 1998.

11:00 - 12:00 p.m: Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before heading to train station.

13:00 p.m: Drop off at Beijing West Train Station and take G87 (14:00 - 18:20) to Xian.

18:20 p.m: Picked up by your private Xian driver at the North Railway Station, you will head for
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Xian hotel for rest.

Day 5: Terracotta Soldiers Museum, Big Wild Goose Pagoda, City Wall

09:00 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide, your exploration to this great city begins.

09:50 a.m: You will arrive at **Terracotta Warriors Museum**. Your tour guide will take you through every important figures, horses or weapons. By examining the terracotta figures discovered here, you can imagine how Qin soldiers looked like 2000 years ago. From the horse cart and weapons displayed, you will have an idea how these soldiers used to fight. If you look closely enough, you will discover that each figure has different facial expressions, which is very astonishing considering how many figures are there. Then, you will know how great this work must be and why the Terracotta Warriors Museum is regarded as the eighth wonder in the world.

12:00 p.m: Time to hunt for lunch. You will need to cover this fee on spot. Your tour guide will be happy to cater to your needs and find the suitable restaurant for you. Here are some local food you might be interested in: Chinese Hamburger, Baozi (steamed stuffed bun), Spicy soup, Tofu Jelly, Deep - fried dough sticks, Pita Bread Soaked in Mutton Soup, Biang Biang Noodles, Guokui, etc..

13:00 p.m: Depart Terracotta Warriors and get back to the city. It takes about 50 minutes to get back to City from the Terracotta Warriors museum, during which time you can have a little rest and be prepared for the afternoon tour.

13:50p.m - 15:20 p.m: Your afternoon tour will start with a visit to **Big Wild Goose Pagoda**. It's locate inside the Da Ci En temple. It was built in Tang Dynasty to store all the Buddhism sutra and Buddhism figures that Xuan Zang has brought back from India. It's the biggest and also the earliest square pagoda that has been built. Now, it has been remodeled and enlarged like a large park. In the sunny days, local people usually come here and relax themselves. If you come here at night, you will see local people dancing, singing, children running, fountain show performing, and various small stalls setting up for local snacks.

15:30 - 17:00p.m: Visit the **Ancient City Wall**, there are two choices available. You can either walk or ride a bike, or even take a golf car (please pay on moment if you want to ride bikes or golf car).

This City Wall is the best preserved and most complete wall that has survived through China's long history. It is about 12 meters high, 12 to 14 meters wide across the top and 15 to 18 meters thick at the bottom. The entire circumference is about 13.7 kilometers. It can take a while if you choose to walk all through.

17: 00p.m: Your will be dropped off at hotel and your tour comes to an end.

Day 6: Bell Tower, Muslim Quarter, Hanyangling Museum, leave for Chengdu

09:00 p.m: Get ready to be picked up by your smiley tour guide.

09:30 - 10:10 a.m: Visit the symbol of Xian city - **Bell Tower (Or Drum Tower)**. In ancient times, the bell and the drum were used to strike time in the morning and at dusk because people didn't have clocks or watches, so there is a saying 'Morning Bell and Dusk Drum' in Chinese. The two towers are the name card of Xi'an, as they are the best preserved all around China.

10:10 - 11:00 p.m: Wander in **Muslim Quarter**. As a block famous for its various food, although the Muslim Quarter is regarded as a tourism spot for the tourists coming from other places, the locals considered it as the place for snacks and entertainment. Especially in summer, you can find tons of local people having snacks and amusing themselves there. In fact, all the "Huifang" area is filled with restaurants, various Muslim food stalls, in which you can find the widely-praised old shops. In here, you can find the true Xian lifestyle. However, these places need your further discovery.

11:00 - 12:00p .m: Enjoy a Chinese lunch at somewhere local usually go. You will need to cover this expense on spot. You may try something different from what you had in the last day.

13: 40 - 15: 00 p.m: Start your day tour with the only underground museum in China - **Hanyangling Museum**, also called Jingdi's Tomb. It is located near the airport about 30km north of Xian City. This is a burial sight for Emperor Jingdi and his wife Empress Wangzhi. This tomb could be dated back to 2,100 years ago. You will see some of the funeral goods such as pottery figurines dated back to Han Dynasty, Luoqing Stone that was used for measurement, and all kinds of stela inscribed with words.

15:20 p.m: Drop off at Xian North Railway Station and take D1943, 16:16 - 20:33 heading for Chengdu.

20: 33 p.m: Your Chengdu local driver will be waiting at Chengdu East Train Station and transfer
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you back to Chengdu hotel.

Day 7: Panda Breeding Center, Wuhou Memorial Temple, Jinli Street.

09:00 a.m: Greeted by your Chengdu guide, you will set out to explore this amazing city.

09:30 - 12:00 p.m: Visit **Panda Breeding Center**. Coming to Chengdu, Panda - the “National Treasure of China” is must-see sight. Situated on the Futou Mountain 10 km away from the city center, Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding is a huge replica of natural habitat for the preservation and breeding of pandas so as to prevent them from extinction. Founded in 1987, Chengdu Panda Base has rescued many wild pandas and survived over 100 kinds of wild animals, including the red panda, the white stork, the white swan, the black swan, the mandarin duck, the *Grus nigricollis* etc.. Besides the rare animals, the Base is also abundant in rare-bred plants. It would be a interesting to see pandas doing all kinds of stuff.

12:00 - 13:00 p.m: Find a local restaurant to enjoy the authentic Sichuan cuisine (pay on spot). As we all know that Sichuan cuisine is world famous, now it's time for you to try the real dishes.

13:30 - 15:00 p.m: Go to **Wuhou Memorial Temple**. As the “Shrine of the Three Kingdoms” , Wuhou Memorial Temple is mainly composed of three sightseeing parts, the Cultural Relics Area, the Garden and Jinli Street. In the Cultural Relics Area, visitors can appreciate Du Fu (a great poet in Tang Dynasty)' s couplets, exquisite carvings, sophisticated stone inscriptions, calligraphy works and paintings, as well as the rooms Zhuge Liang lived in and statues of famous people in Three Kingdoms Period.

15:20- 16:30 p.m: Stroll in **Jinli** old street. It is said that Jinli was one of the oldest and most commercial-featured street in Western Shu Kingdom. It was nation-wide famous back in Qin, Han Dynasties and Three Kingdoms Period. As part of Wuhou Street, Jinli street has internalized the cultural deposition from Qin, Han Dynasties and Three Kingdoms Period, enriched itself with old folk customs of western Sichuan people while displaying in Ming and Qing Dynasties style. It's a great chance for you to learn about old Sichuan people's life by having a cup of tea in the tea house, enjoying a piece of Sichuan Opera in theater, tasting traditional snacks, and appreciate some art works.

17:00 p.m: Come back to Chengdu hotel for rest.

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Day 8: Giant Buddha, Huanglongxi Ancient Town

07:30 a.m: Get up early and be prepared to visit the Giant Buddha.

09:30 - 11:00 a.m: Visit the **Giant Buddha** in Leshan city. It's located at the river outlet of Min River, Qingyi River and Dadu River, over 160km north away from Chengdu city. Built on the cliff based on Xixia Peak of Lingyun Mountain, Giant Buddha was the largest stone-carved Buddha with height of 71 meters. There are two ways to admire this giant Buddha. The ordinary way is to go inside the site and come down the foot of the Buddha. The other way is ride a cruise and watch it in a distance, which provides better views.

11:00 - 12:00 p.m: Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant nearby Giant Buddha (pay on spot).

13:30 - 15:30 p.m: Visit the **Huanglongxi Ancient Town**. Named after Huanglong River that runs through, Huanglongxi Ancient Town has a history of 1,700 years. Most of its buildings date back to Qing Dynasty, featured with cobbled streets, wooden buildings, tranquil tea houses, tall old trees and temples. Coming here will make anybody calm and peaceful. It's precisely these facts attracts many producers come here and shoot movies.

16:30 p.m: Transfer back to Chengdu hotel for rest.

Day 9: Take train to Chongqing, Ancient Town of Ciqikou, Three Gorges Museum, Liberation Stele, People's Park, aboard the Yangtze River Cruise.

07:00 a.m: Chengdu hotel pick up and Chengdu North Train Station drop off for train G2883 (08:50 - 10:09).

10:09 a.m: Chongqing North Train Station pick up and you will start your tour right away.

10:40 a.m - 12:30 p.m: Stroll in the **Ciqikou** old streets. The Ciqikou Town was an important place for china production in old time. Now it's just a good place for local people to relax. Walking in the Ming and Qing style streets, you can access into the local residences like Tong's Yard and Zhong's Yard to learn about the local folk customs. Then, sit in a tea house and sip a cup of tea while enjoying a local person doing storytelling or performing Sichuan opera.

12:30 - 13:30 p.m: Follow your guide to hunt for the local food.

13:30 - 15:00 p.m: Visit **Three Gorges Museum**. Located in the west side of the People's Square,
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the museum houses over 10000 antiques including ancient Bashu bronzes and Han Dynasty sculptures. The building top is like a giant plate that holding water, meaning that the water of Three Gorges are coming from the heaven. Seeing outside, the outer wall is composed of blue glass and gritstone that indicating water and mountain separately. Going inside the museum, you will discover that the museum consists of four floors each representing different topics covering from Splendid Three Gorges, Ancient Chongqing, Urbanized Chongqing, and priceless calligraphy and paintings from different times, etc.. Visiting Three Gorges Museum will enable you to have a general idea of how three gorges like and how Chongqing people made their way in the modern China.

15:00- 16:00p.m: Pay a visit to **Liberation Stele**. It was built in 1940 after the nationalist party government moved the capital city from Nanjing to Chongqing when Japanese army invaded China to inspire common people to join army and resist against the enemies. In 1950, the stele was renamed as liberation stele. With the fast commercialization of its surroundings, the stele stands there quietly telling people the stories of old fighting times and warning people to treasure today's good life.

16:00 - 19:00 p.m: Go inside the **People's Park** and meet local people. In the afternoon, you will see lots of local people either strolling or doing exercises there. You are most welcome to join. In the following two hours, you are free to explore on your own and have dinner.

20:00 p.m: Drop off at the port and aboard the Yangtze River Cruise.

Day 10: Ghost Town - Fengdu

After breakfast, you will disembark the cruise to the famous Ghost Town - Fengdu. Situated in the southeast of Sichuan Basin, Fengdu is said to be the domicile of ghosts. There are sites like Guimen Gate, Naihe Bridge, Shuanggui Mountain, Yinsi Street, etc., all of which are related to Ghost culture. Our tour guide will fill you with many folk stories about ghosts. Regardless of whether you believe the existence of ghost or not, it's interesting enough to feel the atmosphere. At noon, you will be back for lunch. Afternoon is a free time for you. You can choose to visit Shibaozhai (220 RMB per person) or just hang out on the cruise.

In the afternoon, you will participate in the Captain Welcome Reception and enjoy the
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performance prepared by the cruise staff.

Day 11: Qutang Gorge - Wu Gorge

In the morning, you will enjoy the abundant International Buffet Breakfast served on cruise. Then, it's time for sightseeing. You may choose to skip the self-paying site - Baidi Town (290 RMB per person) and be free. Next site coming to your eyes will be **Qutang Gorge**. Although this gorge is the shortest one in Three Gorges (8 km long), it's the most spectacular one. There is Chijia Mountain piled with red stones standing in the left. While in the right, there is Baiyan Mountain. They are like two magnificent guardians protecting the gorge and make the Yangtze River a narrow line less than 100 meters wide. You will see a variety of stones in different shapes. Each one of them are so unique.

Then, you will enjoy lunch at the cafeteria. In the afternoon, the cruise will take you to the famous **Wu Gorge**. Flowing in the stretching mountains, the Wu Gorge is like a magical band performing various sounds, sometimes stimulating, sometimes low-spirited, while sometimes melodious. Besides the lively river, you will also see a precipitous mountain - Shennv Mountain. Shennv in Chinese means a goddess, which indicates that the mountain is named after its unique shape. A lot of interesting stories will be told about it.

Now, it's time for dinner. After enjoying the dinner, you will take part in the entertainment activities on the cruise.

Day 12: Disembark the cruise, Three Gorges Dam. Fly to Shanghai. Airport-hotel transfer. (B)

Today, you will disembark the cruise and visit the **Three Gorges Dam** on bus.

As the largest hydroelectric power station in the world, Three Gorges Dam has a great significance in China history. It is a multi-functional project, like support shipping, agriculture, power generating, etc.. Standing on the Tanziling observation platform, you will see various mountains and wide river with the dam right in the middle. With the establishment of the dam, Yangtze River from Yichang to Chongqing part has become an artificial lake with the length of 600km. Under the explanation of your tour guide, you will be amazed by the sight.

By now, you have finished all your cruise tour. You will be transferred to the airport and head for
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Shanghai. Our Shanghai local driver will be waiting for you upon your arrival.

Day 13: Shanghai Museum, Yuyuan Garden, Huangpu River Cruise, the Bund

09:00 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide at an appointed time at your hotel lobby, you will start your tour.

09:20 - 12:00 p.m: Visit the **Shanghai Museum**. As one of the renown ancient art museums, Shanghai Museum has collected about 140,000 cultural relics. There are 10 classes of relics displayed now. To appreciate the most spectacular relics in such a limited time period, our tour guides will introduce to you some of the historic ones. You will see ceremonious wares like battle-axe and tripod, daily necessities in ancient life like pottery and porcelain, calligraphy works like Oracle, and various jade ornaments.

12:00 - 13:00 p.m: Lunch at your own cost under the recommendations of your tour guide.

13:00 - 15:00p.m: In the afternoon, you will visit the **Yuyuan Garden**. Dating back to 400 years ago, Yuyuan Garden was a private garden. It was built as most of the classic Jiangnan gardens. You will see Yu Linglong - a unique stone listed as one of the 3 famous stones in Jiangnan. The other two refers to Guan Yunfeng in Liu Garden of Suzhou and Zhou Yunfeng in Zhusu Garden of Hangzhou. Our guide will also brief you about the local gourmet you will come into.

15:20 - 16:00 p.m: Wander in **the Bund**. It is the scenery line of Shanghai and literally the most beautiful place there. You will see people are walking and laughing, large modern buildings are erecting into the sky and waves are slapping the shore. If you are interested, you can also participate the dancing group there. The locals would be very happy to coach you!

17:00 - 18:30 p.m: You will enjoy the **Huangpu River Cruise**. All the Shanghai essences are unfolded along the Huangpu River. Taking this cruise will be the most memorable experience for you! You will take a 3-floor cruise ship built as a typical ancient Chinese boat with two magnificent dragon heads standing upright on the stem. Under the explanation of the guide, you will enjoy the mild wind, smell the unique water, and view the colorful buildings aside the river, while listening the old Shanghai stories.

19:00 p.m: Your tour comes to an end by now, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Day 14: Departure Shanghai

You will be picked up 3 hours prior to your flight and dropped off at Shanghai airport.

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4. The tour we provide you are based on days, not the hours. A regular day tour will last 8-9 hours. In case you only need our service for over 6 hours yet less than 8 hours in one day, we will consider it a day tour.
5. Please be aware that your itinerary is changeable anytime. Whenever you want to adjust it, we will help you with that.
6. What we provide are high-quality private tours, you will be only with your families or friends. There are no other people joining your tour.
7. Wheelchairs are accessible, please advise prior to your trip in case you need any.
8. Please advise in advance in case you want to enjoy the Acrobatic show or Kungfu Show.
9. Please advise prior to your trip if you want to do some activities such as painting, calligraphy, exercising Tai Chi, watching opera, paper cutting, etc..
10. Please advise in advance if you want to take high-speed train to Shanghai from Xian instead.

FAQ

1. Do we need the contacts for the drivers picking us up in Chong Qing, Yi Chang and Shanghai?

Re: No worries, we will make sure all the drivers you need are in place. If you have trouble finding them, you can contact me since the driver don't speak English.

2. May I check how to book the bullet trains to and from xi an and Beijing, and how much does it cost per ticket in first class? Also how long does the train take each way?

Re: I suggest you could buy the bullet train tickets on Ctrip where you can reserve train tickets earlier than book from the official website. Usually the train takes around 4.5 hour-5hours , the first class seat ticket price is 825RMB each person each way. If you are worried the tickets might be lost on the way since you have pay for the tickets beforehand , we could help you to book the tickets as well, there is a ticket office in our agent that they could arrange all the tickets, they charge 50RMB each ticket for buying ticket and sending it to your hotel service in person or send the tickets to our tour guide in Beijing, when the tour starts in Beijing , the guide will give you the tickets and help you to explain the tickets to you. if you want me to help you arrange the tickets, please give me your

full names and your passport number.

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3. We would also like to include many of the optional items such as the acrobatic show and Peking duck meal in Beijing / he tang dynasty show and dinner in xi an / Sichuan Opera Performance in Chengdu - could you add that into the quotation for us?

Re: Sure, no problem, just let me know which activity you are interested in. I will include the fee for you.

4. We also want to ask if we decide meals on our own, will it be taken out of the quotation?

Re: Sure, you can decide your meals on your own. It' s not included in the quotation.

5. How do we confirm this tour?

Re: When you are ok with all the arrangement, and want to secure this tour with Lilysun China Tours. We will send a deposit request for you to make the payment. Then, we will send the confirmation paper to you which indicating this trip is officially confirmed with Lilysun China Tours.

6. What is the balance when we reach Beijing? Do we pay in rmb or usd? And who do we pay to?

Re: Please refer to your confirmation about your balance. You can pay in both USD and RMB to your Xian tour guide.

7. Is it true that if we stay in China for more than 15 days we will need to apply for a Chinese visa?

Re: As far as we know, the allow visa-free entry only apply to the foreign tourists who stay in China within 72 hours. When time out, then you have to get visas.

8. Can we pay through Alipay or sth?

Re: Yes, we can accept Alipay, Paypal, and bank transfer.

9. What kind of car will we have?

Re: It depends on your group size. For group size of 1-2 people, you will be offered with a sedan car.

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For group size of 3-4 people, you will enjoy a van with 7-seat. While 14-17-seat van will be in service if there are 5-8 of you. When your tour group size is larger, 33-seat coach or bigger will be offered.

10. Can you help us booking the train tickets?

Re: Sure, we can help you to book all the train tickets or flight tickets. This is one of our service features. After booking the tickets, your paper train tickets would be expressed to your Beijing hotel before you can use.

11. Can I confirm this is a private tour?
