Overview: Upon arrival in the capital city of China, you will pay a visit to the most noted sites

as Forbidden City for hidden halls and Great Wall in the first two days. Take a high-speed train

southward to Xian, another ancient capital city, you will dive into the culture of Terracotta

Warriors and Horses and the biking on City Wall would be an interesting experience. Hope on

another railway and head for Chengdu, a mixed place for fun and food. Visit the Giant Panda

Breeding Center whilst you will enjoy the local Sichuan cuisine, which tastes nothing like the

so-called Sichuan food back home. Take a flight and go to Guilin, a beautiful natural city. Take a

Li River Cruise and have a leisure time. Before heading back to home, you will complete your last

tour in Shanghai by discovering the tranquil temples and getting into local people's life.

Highlights:

1. Get close to cute Giant pandas and learn about how to breed them.

2. Take a cruise on the picturesque Li River and know from locals how this human paradise is

formed.

3. Scrutinize the appearance of each Terracotta Warrior with a telescope and learn how they were

made.

4. Access the newly available halls and palace to discover more secrets of ancient imperial lives.

5. Be dazzled by the modern charm of Shanghai by getting onto the World Financial Center.

6. Open your mind by the grand Great Wall.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Beijing

Your driver will be ready at the airport when you arrive and transfer you to hotel. You are advise



to use this half day to ease jet lag.

Day 2: Tian'anmen Square, Forbidden City, Temple of Heaven, Hutong Walking Tour

09:00 a.m: Meet your Beijing tour guide and start your China tour. This day tour will mainly take

place in Beijing city, after which you are recommended to have a Peking Roast Duck banquet.

09:30-10:30 a.m: Visit Tian'anmen Square. With a history of over 500 years, Tian'anmen Square

is the largest city square in the world. It's located in the south side of Forbidden City, functioning

as the very gate for the imperial palace in Ming and Qing Dynasty. It was in here that the founding

of New People's Republic of China was loudly announced. In the following years, there are

several historic events happened here that made it a political idol for Chinese people.

10:40 - 13:00 p.m: Visit the magnificent Forbidden City, the largest Imperial Palace in the world.

We'll spend a couple of hours wandering around this amazing example of Imperial architecture

and learning about the history of the palace. Surrounded by a long scarlet walls longing 3.5km,

UNESCO-listed Forbidden City is the very central power in Ming and Qing Dynasty. This large

palace witness the prosperity and the decline of feudalism. From here, you will have a direct

experience how royals lived and how they rule.

13:00 - 14:00 p.m: Enjoy a local food in a nice restaurant Beijingers always visit, please pay on

moment based on what you have.

14:30 - 16:00 p.m: Head for **Temple of Heaven**. Situated in the southeast of central city, the

Temple of Heaven was originally constructed in the eighteenth year of Yong Le (1420) in Ming

Dynasty for Ming and Qing emperors to conduct annual ceremonies of praying to Heaven for good

harvest. It combines the architectural technology of Ming and Qing Dynasties together, which

makes it a rare Chinese ancient architecture and the largest sacrifice complex in the world.

Charmed by its size, colorful meaning and importance in China's history, the site was classified into

the "Directory of World Heritage" by UNESCO in 1998.

16:10- 17:00 p.m: Walk in the tranquil Hutongs. In those interlaced Hutongs, one can experience

the life of the ancient Beijing people. With bathrooms and public toilets usually being found, shops

and vendors selling all kinds of goods that satisfy the local people's daily needs, and people



gossiping along the lanes to strengthen their relationship, one can walk through the history and savor the unique culture. Thus, we can say that where there is such a lane, there is a story.

17:00 p.m: End of this day tour and return to hotel for rest.

Day 3: Mutianyu Great Wall, Summer Palace

07:30 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide in your hotel lobby and commence your day tour.

09:00 - 12:30 p.m: Drive around 1.5 hours to the **Mutianyu section Great Wall** and you will take a rest and lunch at the Subway down the foot of the Mutianyu Wall. This is a one of the most famous and ideal sections of the Great Wall. You will have your choice of taking the cable car or chair lift up the breathtaking wall and spend a leisurely 1 to 2 hours hiking up and down the various sections exploring the Watch Towers and marveling at the construction and beauty of the renown and legendary Wall. You then have the option of an exhilarating toboggan ride back down or simply return the way you came with cable car.

12:30 - 13:30 p.m: Enjoy a typical Beijing lunch nearby the Mutianyu Great Wall (pay on moment). 14:30 - 16:00 p.m: Visit the **Summer Palace**. As the largest imperial garden in China, the Summer Palace has been a summer resort for royal families. There are huge lakes, bridges, corridors, pavilions, and various kinds of flowers and lots of rooms fully radiating the natural beauty and the grandeur of imperial gardens. With arched bridges and glittering ripples, pretty promenades and flowers in blossom, decorated corridors and ancient doors, and "breezeways" (a kind of hallway that allows the passage of a breeze between structures), all these can bring tourists into an enchanting and ever-changing scenery.

16:30 p.m: You will be back to your hotel for rest.

Day 4: Leave for Xian by G571 (09:22-15:03), Hanyangling Museum

07:30 a.m: Your Beijing driver will pick you up from hotel and transfer you to Beijing West Train Station.

15:03 p.m: Your Xian guide will be waiting for you at Xian North Railway Station.

Greeted by your guide, you will visit Hanyangling Museum directly. Located about 20 mins from



the train station, this mausoleum is said to be the most underrated tomb in China. This is a burial sight for Emperor Jingdi and his wife Empress Wangzhi. This tomb could be dated back to 2,100 years ago. You will see some of the funeral goods such as pottery figurines dated back to Han Dynasty, Luojing Stone that was used for measurement, and all kinds of stela inscribed with words indicating the prosperity of Han Dynasty.

18:00 p.m: Drop off at your hotel for rest.

Day 5: Terracotta Soldiers Museum, Big Wild Goose Pagoda, City Wall

09:00 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide, your exploration to this great city begins.

09:50 a.m: You will arrive at **Terracotta Warriors Museum**. Your tour guide will take you through every important figures, horses or weapons. By examining the terracotta figures discovered here, you can imagine how Qin soldiers looked like 2000 years ago. From the horse cart and weapons displayed, you will have an idea how these soldiers used to fight. If you look closely enough, you will discover that each figure has different facial expressions, which is very astonishing considering how many figures are there. Then, you will know how great this work must be and why the Terracotta Warriors Museum is regarded as the eighth wonder in the world.

12:00 p.m: Time to hunt for lunch. You will need to cover this fee on spot. Your tour guide will be happy to cater to your needs and find the suitable restaurant for you. Here are some local food you might be interested in: Chinese Hamburger, Baozi (steamed stuffed bun), Spicy soup, Tofu Jelly, Deep - fried dough sticks, Pita Bread Soaked in Mutton Soup, Biang Biang Noodles, Guokui, etc..
13:00 p.m: Depart Terracotta Warriors and get back to the city. It takes about 50 minutes to get back to City from the Terracotta Warriors museum, during which time you can have a little rest and be prepared for the afternoon tour.

13:50p.m - 15:20 p.m: Your afternoon tour will start with a visit to **Big Wild Goose Pagoda**. It's locate inside the Da Ci En temple. It was built in Tang Dynasty to store all the Buddhism sutra and Buddhism figures that Xuan Zang has brought back from India. It's the biggest and also the earliest square pagoda that has been built. Now, it has been remodeled and enlarged like a large park. In the sunny days, local people usually come here and relax themselves. If you come here at night, you will



see local people dancing, singing, children running, fountain show performing, and various small stalls setting up for local snacks.

15:30 - 17:00p.m: Visit the **Ancient City Wall**, there are two choices available. You can either walk or ride a bike, or even take a golf car (please pay on moment if you want to ride bikes or golf car). This City Wall is the best preserved and most complete wall that has survived through China's long history. It is about 12 meters high, 12 to 14 meters wide across the top and 15 to 18 meters thick at the bottom. The entire circumference is about 13.7 kilometers. It can take a while if you choose to walk all through.

17: OOp.m: Your will be dropped off at hotel and your tour comes to an end.

Day 6: Shaanxi History Museum, Bell Tower, Muslim Quarter, head for Chengdu by train D1943, 16:16 - 20:33

09:00 p.m: Get ready to be picked up by your smiley tour guide.

09:10 - 12:00 a.m: Visit grand **Shaanxi History Museum**. Xian was the ancient imperial capital of China, having been the seat of more than 13 feudal dynasties, including the Zhou, Qin, Han, and Tang dynasties. The province is rich in cultural relics. With the completion of the Shaanxi History Museum, it collected over 370,000 precious relics which were unearthed in Shaanxi Province, including bronze wares, pottery figures, and mural paintings in Tang tombs.

12:00 - 13:00p .m: Enjoy a Chinese lunch at somewhere local usually go. You will need to cover this expense on spot. You may try something different from what you had in the last day.

13:10 - 13:50 p.m: Visit the symbol of Xian city - **Bell Tower (Or Drum Tower).** In ancient times, the bell and the drum were used to strike time in the morning and at dusk because people didn't have clocks or watches, so there is a saying 'Morning Bell and Dusk Drum' in Chinese. The two towers are the name card of Xi'an, as they are the best preserved all around China.

14:00 - 14:40 p.m: Wander in **Muslim Quarter**. As a block famous for its various food, although the Muslim Quarter is regarded as a tourism spot for the tourists coming from other places, the locals considered it as the place for snacks and entertainment. Especially in summer, you can find tons of local people having snacks and amusing themselves there. In fact, all the "Huifang" area is filled



with restaurants, various Muslim food stalls, in which you can find the widely-praised old shops. In here, you can find the true Xian lifestyle. However, these places need your further discovery. 15:20 p.m: Drop off at Xian North Railway Station and take D1943, 16:16 - 20:33 heading for Chengdu.

20: 33 p.m: Your Chengdu local driver will be waiting at Chengdu East Train Station and transfer you back to Chengdu hotel.

Day 7: Giant Buddha, Huanglongxi Ancient Town

07:30 a.m: Get up early and be prepared to visit the Giant Buddha.

09:30 - 11:00 a.m: Visit the **Giant Buddha** in Leshan city. It's located at the river outlet of Min River, Qingyi River and Dadu River, over 160km north away from Chengdu city. Built on the cliff based on Xixia Peak of Lingyun Mountain, Giant Buddha was the largest stone-carved Buddha with height of 71 meters. There are two ways to admire this giant Buddha. The ordinary way is to go inside the site and come down the foot of the Buddha. The other way is ride a cruise and watch it in a distance, which provides better views.

11:00 - 12:00 p.m: Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant nearby Giant Buddha (pay on spot).

13:30 - 15:30 p.m: Visit the **Huanglongxi Ancient Town**. Named after Huanglong River that runs through, Huanglongxi Ancient Town has a history of 1,700 years. Most of its buildings date back to Qing Dynasty, featured with cobbled streets, wooden buildings, tranquil tea houses, tall old trees and temples. Coming here will make anybody calm and peaceful. It's precisely these facts attracts many producers come here and shoot movies.

16:30 p.m: Transfer back to Chengdu hotel for rest.

Day 8: Panda Breeding Center, Wuhou Memorial Temple, Jinli Street, fly to Guilin by CA19:15 - 20:55

 $og: oo \ a.m:$ Greeted by your Chengdu guide, you will set out to explore this amazing city.

09:30 - 12:00 p.m: Visit **Panda Breeding Center**. Coming to Chengdu, Panda - the "National Treasure of China" is must-see sight. Situated on the Futou Mountain 10 km away from the city



center, Chengdu Research Base of Giant Panda Breeding is a huge replica of natural habitat for the preservation and breeding of pandas so as to prevent them from extinction. Founded in 1987, Chengdu Panda Base has rescued many wild pandas and survived over 100 kinds of wild animals, including the red panda, the white stork, the white swan, the black swan, the mandarin duck, the Grus nigricollis etc.. Besides the rare animals, the Base is also abundant in rare-bred plants. It would be a interesting to see pandas doing all kinds of stuff.

12:00 - 13:00 p.m: Find a local restaurant to enjoy the authentic Sichuan cuisine (pay on spot). As we all know that Sichuan cuisine is world famous, now it's time for you to try the real dishes.

13:30 - 15:00 p.m: Go to **Wuhou Memorial Temple**. As the "Shrine of the Three Kingdoms",

Wuhou Memorial Temple is mainly composed of three sightseeing parts, the Cultural Relics Area,
the Garden and Jinli Street. In the Cultural Relics Area, visitors can appreciate Du Fu (a great poet in Tang Dynasty)'s couplets, exquisite carvings, sophisticated stone inscriptions, calligraphy works and paintings, as well as the rooms Zhuge Liang lived in and statues of famous people in Three Kingdoms Period.

15:20- 16:30 p.m: Stroll in **Jinli** old street. It is said that Jinli was one of the oldest and most commercial-featured street in Western Shu Kingdom. It was nation-wide famous back in Qin, Han Dynasties and Three Kingdoms Period. As part of Wuhou Street, Jinli street has internalized the cultural deposition from Qin, Han Dynasties and Three Kingdoms Period, enriched itself with old folk customs of western Sichuan people while displaying in Ming and Qing Dynasties style. It's a great chance for you to learn about old Sichuan people's life by having a cup of tea in the tea house, enjoying a piece of Sichuan Opera in theater, tasting traditional snacks, and appreciate some art works.

17:15 p.m: Drop off at Chengdu airport. You will fly to Guilin. 20:55 p.m: Guilin airport pick up and Guilin hotel drop off.

Day 9: Longji Terraces

07:30 a.m: Meet your tour guide and head for Longji Terraces Rice Fields.

09:30 a.m - 15:00 p.m: Enjoy the amazing natural views of Longji Terraces and taste the

authentic Zhuang nationality food. Situated about 27 kilometers southeast of Longsheng County,

there is a vast region of rice terraces stretching layer upon layer. It is Longji Rice Terraces

(Dragon Backbone's Rice Terraces), an grand terrace in China! Since the construction in Yuan

Dynasty (1271-1368), the terrace was completed till the early Qing Dynasty (1644-1911). It

represents a great accomplishment of profound wisdom and strenuous labor of minority people in

South China.

With the passage of four different seasons, the terrace shows people various kinds of sceneries,

displaying a grandeur of great nature. In spring, with the irrigation, the terrace presents a picture

of chains or ribbons hung on the hillsides. With the coming of Summer, massive green shadows

upon the terrace from the heaven. With the commencement of Autumn, ripened millet blends the

stems, giving people hope of harvest. In winter, the whole terrace is covered with white snow like

a playful dragon.

Wondering in the terrace, one can not only enjoy the natural beauty, but also experience the unique

culture of ethnic minorities. There are several minorities, including Zhuang, Miao and Yao. One

can visit their wooden buildings, learn their beautiful dances and appreciate their costumes and

Longji tea.

17:00 p.m: Guilin Hotel drop off at the tour end.

Day 10 Li River Cruise, West Street and Yangshuo countryside, flight to Shanghai by MU9378,

19:45 - 22:05

09:00 a.m: Meet your tour guide and start your Guilin hotel.

09:00 - 13:00 p.m: Coming to Guilin, Li River Cruise is an activity you simply can't miss.

Surrounded by the stretching mountains in both sides, Li River is meandering through slowly and

quietly. You will aboard the shop prepared for you and enjoy the picturesque natural views. With

the swimming ducks, napping fisherman on the bank, and buffaloes eating green grass, you will

feel like wandering in the fairyland. The ship will lead you to Yangshuo.

Please be aware that your lunch is included in the cruise.

14:30 - 16:00 p.m: Disembarking the ship, you will you will find yourselves into a splendid



picture. Brooks are gurgling on the ground. Verdant trees are erecting on both sides and dancing with the wind. Birds are singing. Mountains are fading into distance. Being in such a relaxing and picturesque place, you can ride a bike going down the paths. With the guidance of our

representative, you can also learn some facts and history of Yangshuo.

16:00 - 17:00 p.m: Wander in West Street. West Street is a street featured with western style. It's an unique cultural symbol in Yangshuo. Because of its existence, every foreigners feel welcomed and like home. As the first western-style street, West Street has been a model for other tourist cities to clone from. Coming here, you will see various kinds of western stores and shops selling

traditional Chinese decorates like small embroidery pouch, Chinese knots, and lucky bag.

17:50 p.m: Drop off at Guilin airport and take a flight to Shanghai.

22:05 p.m: Shanghai driver pick you up at PVG airport and drop you off at Shanghai hotel.

Day 11: Shanghai Museum, Yuyuan Garden, Huangpu River Cruise, the Bund.

09: 00 a.m: Greeted by your tour guide at your hotel lobby, you will set out for Shanghai Museum.

09:20 - 12:00 p.m: As one of the renown ancient art museums, Shanghai Museum has collected

about 140,000 cultural relics. There are 10 classes of relics displayed now. To appreciate the most

spectacular relics in such a limited time period, our tour guides will introduce to you some of the

historic ones. You will see ceremonious wares like battle-axe and tripod, daily necessities in

ancient life like pottery and porcelain, calligraphy works like Oracle, and various jade ornaments.

12:00 - 13:00 p.m: Lunch at your own arrangements under the recommendations of our tour guide.

13:00 - 14:30 p.m: After lunch, you will visit the **Yuyuan Garden**. Dating back to 400 years ago,

Yuyuan Garden was a private garden. It was built as most of the classic Jiangnan gardens. You will

see Yu Linglong - a unique stone listed as one of the 3 famous stones in Jiangnan. The other two

refers to Guan Yunfeng in Liu Garden of Suzhou and Zhou Yunfeng in Zhusu Garden of

Hangzhou. Our guide will also brief you about the local gourmet you will run into.

14:50 - 15:20 p.m: Our guide will take you to "climb" the **Shanghai World Financial Center.**

With the height of 492m, Shanghai World Financial Center is ranked as the 3rd tallest tower in the

world. You will view all city standing on the tower.

15:40-16:40 p.m: Visit the Bund. Located at the west bank of Huangpu River in Shanghai, the Bund

was originally a pathway for boatmen and hard laborers; while nowadays, the Bund becomes the

most characteristic view and the most recognized symbol in the city with rich cultural connotations

for hundreds of years. For the Europeans, it was like the Wall Street in the east, where prosperous

trading was proceeded and massive fortunes were made and lost. In the opposite side of the Bund,

it faces other marks of Shanghai City - Oriental Pearl TV Tower and Jinmao Tower. Therefore, it is a

must in your tour in Shanghai.

17:00 p.m: Your tour comes to an end by now, you will be transferred back to your hotel.

Recommended activity: Huangpu River Cruise

In the evening, you are suggested to enjoy the Huangpu River Cruise. All the Shanghai essences

are unfolded along the Huangpu River. Taking this cruise will be the most memorable experience

for you! You will take a 3-floor cruise ship built as a typical ancient Chinese boat with two

magnificent dragon heads standing upright on the stem. Under the explanation of the guide, you

will enjoy the mild wind, smell the unique water, and view the colorful buildings aside the river,

while listening the old Shanghai stories.

Day 12: Zhujiajiao Water Town, departure Shanghai.

09:00 a.m: Meet your Shanghai guide in your hotel lobby and start your Shanghai tour.

09:50-12:00 p.m: Visit Zhujiajiao Water Town. As the best preserved water town in Shanghai,

Zhujiajiao has a history of 1700 years. Also, it's the nearest water town in Shanghai. Unique old

bridges across bubbling streams, small rivers shaded by willow trees, and houses with courtyards

city to a brand-new world full of antiquity, leisure and tranquility. Boat riding fee is not included.

before you can use.

10. Can I confirm this is a private tour?
