Day 1: Mutianyu Great Wall

Upon your arrival at the Capital International Airport, your personal guide and driver will be

The journey from airport to the Mutianyu Great Wall takes about 1.5 hours and on the way, your

personal guide will brief you about the tour. The entire tour takes about 6 hours and you will have

2-3 hours at the sight. Mutianyu Great Wall is the essence of Ming Dynasty Great Wall and a

unique section among all Great Wall sections. There are many watchtowers, passes, and crenels

densely arranged. Being surrounded by mountains, the Mutianyu Great Wall offers different

landscapes in different times. In spring, wild flowers are fighting for attention. In summer, layers

of mountains turn to green and the streams nearby gurgle away. In autumn, red maples spread

everywhere. In winter, the Great Wall looks like a white giant dragon crouching among the

mountain. You will not only admire the stunning views, but learn a lot of interesting stories behind

the wall.

About 3 hours before your flight, your driver will transfer you back to your airport.

FAQ

1. How long do I stay at Mutianyu Great Wall?

A: You will stay there about 2.5 hours, depending your flight schedule.

2. How do I get on to the Great Wall?

A: You can take the carlift up and down with the toboggan, which is already included in the quote.

You may also get down the Great Wall via cable car, the total price is the same as toboggan.

3. What kind of car will I have?

A: It depends on your group size. For group size of 1-2 people, you will be offered with a sedan

car. For group size of 3-4 people, you will enjoy a van with 7-seater. While 14-17-seater van will

be in service if there are 5-8 of you. When your tour group size is larger, 33-seater coach or bigger

will be offered.

4. Can I confirm this is a private tour?

A: Yes, this is a private tour just for your group. No other people will join you.

5. Which is better Badaling or Mutianyu Great Wall?

A: These two sections of Great Wall have their own characteristics. Badaling Great Wall is nearer

to Beijing city, much developed and easier to conquer. However, it's often overcrowded,

especially during holidays. Mutianyu Great Wall is less developed and some parts still remain wild,

and it's far from city. But Mutianyu Great Wall is less crowded, more spectacular. Besides, you

can take toboggans to go down the wall, which can be exhilarating.

6. Can I leave the airport during a layover in China?

A: You can leave the airport, but the real question is whether you should leave. If you only a few

hours, we wouldn't suggest you go all the trouble just be stuck in the traffic (as Beijing is always

crowded). If you have a couple of hours or more during the layover, it's safer to hire a private car.
