

2 Days Adventure Xian Tour

Attractions: Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum, City Wall, Bell or Drum Tower, Muslim Quarter, Mt. Huashan

Overview: Visit Xi'an's holiest and most historically significant sights on this two-day tour of Shaanxi Province, all without the hassle of arranging transport or booking your own tickets. On the first day, visit the Terracotta Warriors in nearby Lintong and then spend the afternoon walking Xi'an's ancient city wall; on the second day, travel east to the precipitous and intimidating Mount Huashan and hike up some of the mountain's many peaks.

- See the Terracotta Warriors and Horses which have been buried for thousand of years;

Day 1: Terracotta Warriors Museum, City Wall, Bell Tower, Muslim Quarter

09:00: Meet your friendly tour guide at your hotel lobby.

09:50 - 13:00: You will leave for a visit to the **Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum**, which is the Eighth Wonder of the World, the biggest on-site museum in China with thousands of Terracotta Warriors and Horses made by the ancient Chinese more than 2,000 years ago. You surely will be impressed by the magnificent formation.



13:00-14:00: Have lunch at a local restaurant (Lunch for your own account).

14:50 - 15:30: Spend a while on the top of the **City Wall**. Standing in Xi'an and protecting it for about 600 years, the City Wall is the best preserved and most complete wall that has survived through China's long history. It is about 12 meters high, 12 to 14 meters wide across the top and 15 to 18 meters thick at the bottom. The entire



circumference is about 13.7 kilometers. You may to take a walk, or ride a bike, or take a golf cart to explore this old but well preserved wall for 90 minutes. This will be quite a fun experience.

15:40 - 16:20: Climb on the **Bell Tower** or Drum Tower and learn about the Tang Dynasty architecture and the timing technology. The Bell Tower is located in the very center of the city and from here you will be able to observe the whole layout of the city.

16:30 - 17:00: Located west of the Bell Tower, the Muslim Quarter was once a place just for

Muslims who had migrated from other places. As time went by, a unique Muslim culture was formed and this place has become a must-see site for anyone coming to Xian. If you wish to hunt for local food, learn about folk art, and explore the mysterious Muslim culture, this is the right place.





17:00: Hotel drop off at the tour end.

Day 2: Mt.Hua Hiking Tour

07:30: Meet your hiking tour guide and set out for the hiking tour.

09:00 - 15:30: Mt. Huashan is located 120 km southeast of Xian City. It takes around 2 hours to get there. You will have an adventure hiking tour. Mt. Huashan is praised as "the First Odd Mountain in the World". It boasts five imposing peaks with sheer precipices and overhanging

rocks. The eastern one is called the 'Peak of the Rising Sun' which is the best location to view sunrise; the northern one, the 'Peak of Cloud Terrace' is famous for cliffs on its three sides; the western one is called the 'Peak of Lotus; the southern one, the 'Peak of Wild Geese' is the main peak and also the steepest of Mt. Hua with an



elevation of 2,083 meters; the Central one is called the 'Peak of the Jade Maiden', and links the east, west and southern peaks. Each presents unique scenic beauty, surrounded by over 70 minor peaks.

17:30: Drop you off at your hotel.

- 3. A regular day tour will last 8-9 hours. If you want a tour with a duration exceeding the working period of our tour guide and driver, we need to charge you for your extra hours at the standard rate of 100 RMB per hour.
- 4. The tour we provide you is based on days, not the hours. A regular day tour will last 8-9 hours. In case you only need our service for between 6 hours to 8 hours in one day, we will consider it a day tour.
- 5. Please be aware that your itinerary can be changed at anytime. Whenever you want to adjust it, we will help you with that.
- 6. In case of the bad weather, you can switch the day trips around.
- What we provide are high-quality private tours, you will be only with your families or friends. There are no other people joining your tour.
- During your visit to the Terracotta Warriors Museum, you may encounter some local people following you to sell souvenirs, just ignore them.
- Just be aware that the costs for food and souvenirs on the mountain are all a little more expensive than other places.





FAQ

1. Does Mt. Hua hiking tour involve a lot of walking?

Re: Not necessarily, you can hike or take the cable car.

2. Mt. Hua seems a bit dangerous, isn't it?

Re: Yes, you may see some dangerous parts of the mountain online, that's what the mountain is famous for. You can avoid the risky parts when you walk.

3. Does the tour guide accompany us up the mountain?

Re: Yes, in usual cases, your tour guide will escort you through your whole adventure on the mountain.

4. Can I take cable car?

Re: Yes, sure. The return-trip cable car up and down the West peak is already included in the quote.

5. How long is the tour in each day?

Re: The tour lasts about 8-9 hours, starting from the time when you leave your hotel.

6. When does the tour usually end in each day?

Re: The tour usually ends at 17:30.

7. How much time do we have in the Terracotta Warriors Museum?

Re: You will have a whole morning or afternoon to wander in the museum and be immersed in the great wonder.

8. How far is the Terracotta Warriors Museum?

Re: It is about 50 mins drive from the city center.



9. Can the itinerary be changed on the spot?

Re: Sure, you can change the itinerary whenever you want. Your tour guide will accommodate your needs.

10. Where do we have lunch?

Re: Your tour guide will take you to a nice local restaurant instead of the tourist ones for lunch. You can try some delicious meter-long noodles. While on Mt. Hua, you will have lunch on mountain for sure. Please bring some snacks to keep you going until lunch.

11. How far is Mt. Hua?

Re: It is about 1.5 hours drive from the city center.
