Please advise in advance if you prefer to have the banquet at a specific restaurant. We will help you to make the appointment. We all know that Beijing Roast Duck is world famous, but why? The core reason is its taste. The authentic roast duck meat has thin,



crisp skin, which tastes extremely fragrant and tender. It's often consumed with the pancakes full of spring onion and sweet bean sauce. There are plenty of restaurant choices in Beijing, but we recommend the Siji Minfu and Dadong Restaurant.

After tasting the delicious duck, you will leave for the Chaoyang Theater where the exciting **Acrobatic Show** is performed. As a traditional art form in China, acrobatics is a skill that explores the extremity of your body. It's precise, daring, and often cause a strong sensation and exclamation among audiences. Let's have a look at some of the classic tricks like lion dancing, stunning bicycling, fire stunts and contortion acts.

## FAQ

1. Can we start early or late for the tour?

Re: If you booked a private tour, it's up to you when to start. However if there are other people joining the tour, we will need to coordinate with them first.

2. When is the Acrobatic Show start?

Re: In this tour, we will catch the last show, which starts at 19:00.

3. How much time do we have for the roast duck banquet?

Re: We have spared about 1.5 hours for the banquet. If you want to prolong it, please check with your guide.

Re: It has a history of about 690 years now.

5. How much is the ticket for Acrobatic Show?
